Review of Cost Projections for Preferred Service Level Model

The Committee was in favor of a three year phase in plan. The cost projection for the 8 personnel staffing level included a \$20.40 incremental increase over a three year period with a 3% inflation adjuster. A sunset clause for the inflation adjuster was discussed without a consensus for a resolution.

Review of Subcommittee Draft Report

After discussion, the Committee was in agreement to send their individual revisions and facts and findings to Chief Thompson, by September 25th, to be included in Chairman Lunn's draft report for October's Advisory Committee meeting. The Committee will review all the facts and findings at their next scheduled meeting and present a final draft to the Board at the regularly scheduled October Board meeting.

Ed Vallerand, of Twentynine Palms, spoke to Agenda Item #2 and questioned the legality of the inflation adjuster beyond a four year time frame.

Review of Voter Turnout History for Local Elections and Discussion on Possible Timeframe of Calling for a Special Tax Ballot Measure

The Committee reviewed the history of voter turnout for various local elections, including water Board and Fire Tax measure elections. Stand-alone mail ballot elections are considered the most expensive, costing approximately \$30,000 and resulting in the least voter turnout. The Committee was in agreement to recommend placing a measure on the November 2014 general election ballot which will have a polling place and should result in a greater turnout.
