11. <u>Management Reports</u>

11.1 Operations

The District responded to 44 Underground Service Alerts, had 0 water main leaks, 2 water meter leaks, 0 service line leaks, 0 fire hydrant repairs, performed 7 customer pressure checks, replaced 10 meters, replaced 1 customer gate valve, and installed 4 new services. 1 water waste inquiry was received. Water production was down 16.58% as compared to the same month in 2013. The 2017 Consumer Confidence report has been mailed out to all ratepayers.

11.2 Finance

Mr. Kaymark reported the revenues are slightly higher as usage increases during the hotter months. Revenues and expenses are tracking as expected.

11.3 General Manager

Mr. Kolisz reported that Matt Shragge represented the District at the Reach Out Morongo Basin Emergency Preparedness and Response Expo. Matt Shragge and Cindy Fowlkes gave a presentation on water conservation to a sixth grade class at Palm Vista Elementary. Following the presentation, the students were given a tour of the Fluoride Treatment Plant. The water tax bill, SB 623, has been abandoned during the budget process. The next CSDA Annual Conference and Exhibitor Showcase will be held in Indian Wells on September 24-27. The Board will be presented with a high usage water bill policy at the next meeting.

12. <u>Future Agenda Items and Staff Tasks/Directors' Comments and Reports</u> Director Coghill would like to see a committee review the schedule of fees.
