BACKGROUND

Back in March, the Board of Directors approved the #2 amendment to the Master Professional Service Agreement with Kennedy Jenks for Well 11B Treatment Evaluation. Well 11B has high natural occurring arsenic, fluoride, and hexavalent chromium. The treatment evaluation would evaluate and identify the most optimal treatment alternatives for removing the three natural occurring constituents at Well 11B.

Currently Well 11B is off-line and the District may have to put out a Chromium Compliance Plan in the future to activate this well.

Today before you is a resolution, designating the General Manager as the authorized representative to apply to the State Water Resources Control Board for funding at Well 11B. The planning application would help fund the desk top study with Kennedy Jenks, column testing of specific treatment processes at the site, California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) requirements and planning, and engineering services to construct at Well 11B.

RECOMMENDATION

Staff is making the recommendation that the Board approves Resolution 25-11 authorizing the General Manager to apply for planning funding through the State Water Resources Control Board.

DISCUSSION OF PROJECT BIDS FOR THE REDUNDANT TREATED

WATER RESERVOIR AND BOOSTER PUMP STATION

BACKGROUND

The District is in the process of looking over construction bids for the redundant finish water reservoir and booster station at the Fluoride Treatment Removal Plant. The significance of this project gives the District the flexibility at the treatment plant to allow the existing finish water reservoir to be taken out of service for cleaning and repairs, while allowing the treatment plant to remain operational. The treatment facility produces just a little over 2.5 million gallons of treated water per day and approximately 56% of the overall potable water supply to the District. This facility is very important to the daily operations of the District. During the summer months the treatment plant cannot be down for long periods of time.

In Early 2024, the Board of Directors directed General Manager to negotiate and sign a contract with Albert A. Webb Associates for engineering services for the new finish water reservoir and booster station at the treatment plant. The scope of work consisted of preliminary design, site visits, site survey, geotechnical investigation, tank sizing, hydraulics, site plan, opinion of probable construction cost, preliminary design report, final design and bid phase. Mid 2025, Webb and Associates completed final design and specification for this project.

During budget discussion for FY 25/26 and 26/27 for the redundant reservoir and booster station project, District staff allocated \$2,370,000.00 for this project. Attached in this staff report is Webb and Associates engineer estimate for the project at \$2,411,900.00. (Exhibit A)

Mid July of this year, District staff posted the construction project on PublicPurchase.com. With the first mandatory pre-bid job walk on July 31, followed by a

second mandatory pre-bid job walk on August 14. The District was looking at a potential of six bidders for the project. Final bids for construction of the redundant reservoir and booster station where to be received no later than September 25 at 2:00pm. After receiving bids at 2:00 pm on September 25, District staff did a public reading of the bid results:

All four bids have all come in above the engineer estimate, on the low end 37% over the engineer estimate and on the high end 65% over.

FISCAL IMPACTS

District has allocated for FY 25/26 \$1,670,300.00 and FY 26/27 \$700,000.00 for construction at the Fluoride Treatment Removal Plant.

Call to Order and Roll Call

President Bob Coghill called the Board meeting to order at 4:00 p.m. Those responding to roll call were Directors Michael Arthur, Larry Bowden, Bob Coghill, Randy Leazer, and Amy Woods. Also present were General Manager Matt Shragge, Superintendent Mike Minatrea, Treatment/Production Superintendent Robert Shelton, Financial Consultant Scott Nelsen, and District Secretary Cindy Fowlkes.

<u>Pledge of Allegiance</u> Suzi Horn led the pledge.

1. <u>Discussion of California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) – Notice of Exemption for the Redundant Treat Water Reservoir and Booster Pump Station Project</u>

The project will be located at the Fluoride Removal Plant, east of the finished reservoir, and will not generate air emissions, traffic, or affect public service, or utilities. It will not create excessive noise for neighboring residences and no natural or cultural resources would be affected. The District will contract will Birdseye Planning Group to file a Notice of Exemptions (NOE) with San Bernardino County and State Clearinghouse.

2. <u>Discussion of 2025 Sanitary Survey from the State Water Resources Control Board</u> Division of Drinking Water

The Federal Safe Drinking Water Act, conducted by the State Water Resource Control Board Division of Drinking Water, mandates sanitary surveys to review public water systems to ensure they can safely and adequately deliver drinking water to the public. Employees, Mike, Robert, and Jacob were thanked for taking the representative around the District to conduct the survey. District staff are correcting some minor deficiencies. Leaks and main breaks increased since the last survey, most due to roots from salt trees.

The System was found to be well maintained and operated. The compliance letter noted redundancy, in many parts of the system. It also noted an increase in resiliency as the District actively works to build infrastructure.

The District is working on succession planning. There was notice of an unexpected retirement at the Treatment Plant. Employees are being cross-trained and the District is currently flying an in-house position.

3. Review and Adjust Board Meeting Schedule for November and December

Historically, the Board has changed the date to the third Wednesday of the month to avoid scheduling conflict with the Thanksgiving and Christmas holidays. Staff recommends adjusting the Board meeting schedule in November to the 19th and December to the 17th due to the holidays.

Director Arthur made a motion to adjust the November and December Board meetings to November 19th and December 17th, seconded by Director Bowden, and approved unanimously by all those present.

Director Woods moved to approve the Minutes and Audit List, seconded by Director Arthur, and approved unanimously.

6. Management Reports

6.1 Maintenance

Mike reported that the District responded to 72 Underground Service Alerts, had 0 water main leaks, 2 water meter leaks, 1 service line leak, 5 fire hydrant repairs/maintenance, installed 1 new service, replaced 3 customer gate valves, performed 3 leak audits, painted 0 fire hydrants, performed 9 customer pressure checks, replaced 4 water meters, Tested and exercised emergency generators and sounded wells for August. 0 water waste inquiries were received. There was a total of 552 work orders processed during the month.

6.2 Water Quality

Robert reported water production was down 13.68% as compared to the same month in 2013. 40 routine and 13 special water samples were taken. All special samples tested negative for Colilert. All current wells meet the 2.0 mg/L standard fluoride variance set by the State Water Resource Control Board. All samples tested were below the variance.

6.3 Finance

Scott Nelsen reported on the June and July financials. The fiscal year ended at 106% of budget, due to some unforeseen expenditures, some of which were fire hydrant repairs. The format for Cash and Investments in the July financials has been changed to give a more complete report.

6.4 General Manager

Matt thanked Directors Coghill, Arthur, Leazer, and Bowden for their attendance at the CSDA Annual Conference. The conference was very informative, inspirational, and allows General Managers and Board members to all come together. The sealed bids for the Redundant Reservoir project will be opened tomorrow at 2:00 p.m. Matt thanked Mike and Victoria for their work on the mandated water loss report. The new five year Rate Study has begun. The Desk Top Study has begun for Well 11B. Work Order integration with GIS and the

District's billing system, Springbrook, has launched. This will eliminate the need for paper work orders. It also allows employees in the field to create work orders. The District is flying three positions: Service Worker I, Customer Service I, and Treatment Plant Operator I.

7. <u>Closed Session – Conference with Legal Counsel – Anticipated Litigation</u> Initiation of Litigation, Government Code, Section 54956.9(D)(2) [2 Cases]

Director Leazer moved to enter closed session at 4:45 p.m., seconded by Director Woods, and approved unanimously.

Upon coming out of Closed Session at 5:31 p.m., Director Coghill reported there was no reportable action.

8. <u>Future Agenda Items and Staff Tasks/Directors' Comments and Reports</u>
Director Woods was disappointed that she was unable to attend the conference due to a scheduling conflict that unfortunately was cancelled at the last minute.

Director Bowden enjoyed the conference and attended a breakout session on dealing with hostile boards. He does not see the District board having those types of issues. He also learned the differences between Cities and Special Districts.

Director Arthur attended a breakout session and learned the importance of staff being trained to handle emergencies in the General Manager's absence.

1. ENGINEERING

A. No items to report.

2. WATER QUALITY

- A. <u>Chlorine Levels</u>: Average levels maintained in the storage and distribution system ranged from a low of 0.08 mg/L to a high of 1.53 mg/L. Chlorination point (the point where chlorine is introduced into the distribution system) averages ranged from 0.06 mg/L to 1.92 mg/L.
- B. <u>Bacteria Samples:</u> A total of 50 routine bacteria samples were collected at test points for the storage and distribution system during this past month. In addition 14 special bacteria samples were collected. All routine and special samples indicated ABSENT for Collect.
- C. Fluoride Samples: A total of 15 fluoride samples were collected at established test points for the storage and distribution system, and 18 fluoride samples were taken from potable water production wells. Fluoride levels in the distribution system ranged from a low of .91 mg/L to a high of 1.6 mg/L. Fluoride measurements collected at the wells ranged from a low of 0.35 to a high of 1.6 mg/L.
- D. <u>General Physical:</u> A total of 14 general physical samples were collected from established locations as a part of routine testing requirements. Levels reported for color are <3.0, 1 for threshold odor and <0.10-0.13 for turbidity.
