CONSIDERATION OF ORDINANCE NO. 105**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE TWENTYNINE
PALMS WATER DISTRICT IMPLEMENTING CALIFORNIA ASSEMBLY BILL 1572
PROHIBITING THE USE OF POTABLE WATER FOR THE IRRIGATION OF
NONFUNCTIONAL TURF**

Notice is hereby given that the Board of Directors of the Twentynine Palms Water District will hold a public hearing on July 15, 2026, at 4:00 p.m., or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard, at 72401 Hatch Road, Twentynine Palms, CA, to consider adoption of Ordinance No. 105.

Ordinance No. 105 would implement California Assembly Bill 1572 by prohibiting the use of potable water to irrigate nonfunctional turf on certain properties, including commercial, industrial, and institutional properties, other than a cemetery, and on common areas of homeowners' associations, common interest developments, and community service organizations or similar entities. The proposed ordinance does not apply to residential properties or cemeteries and includes additional exceptions recognized by State law, including for community spaces, and recreational use areas. The proposed ordinance also establishes enforcement procedures, penalties, and appeals.
