I, FRANK M. JORDAN, Secretary of State of the State of California, hereby certify:

That on the 24th day of June, 1954, pursuant to the provisions of the County Water District Law, more particularly Section 30321 of the Water Code, there was received in my office and filed in the official records thereof:

The Certificate of Harry L. Allison, County Clerk and ex officio Clerk of the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Bernardino, per V. Dennis Wardle, Deputy, stating that the formation of a county water district was approved by the voters;

That it is set forth therein that an election was duly called and held in the territory of the proposed district on the 15th day of June, 1954, and that of the 357 votes cast by qualified electors there were 257 votes in favor and 57 votes against the proposition:

"Shall the proposition to form Twentynine Palms County Water District under the County water District Law be adopted?"

I further certify that attached to said Certificate and made a part thereof is a certified copy of the Resolution adopted by said Board of Supervisors on the 21st day of June, 1954, entitled: "Resolution of the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Bernardino, State of California, Canvassing Election Returns and Absentee Ballots, Declaring Results of Election, and Order Declaring District Duly Formed."

Now, therefore, I further certify by reason of the statements made in said Certificate, facts and proceedings set forth in said resolution, and the filing as aforesaid in my office, that a county water district in the County of San Bernardino has been duly incorporated according to the laws of the State of California under the name:

"Twentynine Palms County Water District."
